V. ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS

The acknowledgments section is an un-numbered section that follows the main body of the paper and precedes any lists of symbols and appendices. In REVTeX 4.1, use the `acknowledgments` environment:

```
\begin{acknowledgments}
We are grateful to many colleagues...
\end{acknowledgments}
```

Note the spelling of “acknowledgments.” List individuals in alphabetical order and acknowledge financial support at the end. Do not use familiar names like Ed or Eddie unless the person publishes under that name. *RMP* copy editors have been instructed to delete thanks directed to referees, associate editors, or journal staff for fulfilling their editorial responsibilities.
